Secreted as part of the adaptive immune response by plasma B cells, immunoglobulin G constitutes 75% of Background

serum immunoglobulins. Immunoglobulin G binds to viruses, bacteria, as well as fungi and facilitates their destruction or neutralization via agglutination (and thereby immobilizing them), activation of the compliment cascade, and opsinization for phagocytosis. This product possesses the F(ab')2 fragment, recognized by the two F(ab) fragments yielded from the digestion of the antibody below the disulfide bond hinge region.

This product was prepared from normal serum by delipidation, salt fractionation, ion exchange chromatography followed by pepsin digestion and extensive dialysis against the buffer stated above. Assay by **Purity And Specificity**

immunoeléctrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Golden Syrian Hamster IgG, anti-Golden Syrian Hamster IgG F(ab')2 and anti-Golden Syrian Hamster Serum. No reaction was observed against anti-Golden Syrian Hamster IgG F(c) or anti-Pepsin.
