We recommend adding a carrier protein such as HSA or BSA to 0.1% (i.e. 1.0 mg/mL). For best results aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or colder. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge vial before each opening to dislodge contents from the cap and to clarify if contents are not clear after standing at room temperature.

Application Note	Resistin Dimer Recombinant Protein is suitable as a control for polyclonal or monoclonal anti-Resistin Dimer in immunological assays.
Background	Resistin is a peptide hormone belonging to the class of cysteine-rich secreted proteins which is termed the RELM family and is also described as ADSF (Adipose Tissue-Specific Secretory Factor) and FIZZ3 (Found in Inflammatory Zone). Mouse resistin is produced by adipocytes and may be an important link between obesity and insulin resistance. Recombinant mouse resistin is a non-glycosylated, disulfide-linked homodimer, containing two identical 95 amino acid chains, with a total molecular weight of 20.6 kDa.
Purity And Specificity	Resistin Dimer purity was determined to be greater than 97% as determined by analysis by UV-Spectroscopy at 280nm and by reducing and non-reducing SDS-pAGE.





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Bioactivity of Mouse Resistin Dimer Recombinant Protein. Mouse Resistin (starting at 1,000 ng/mL) was added to human PBMCs 24 hours after isolation. After 48 hours production of IL-8 was measured by ELISA. The ED50 of Mouse Resistin is 400-600 ng/mL. There is no typically expected range for this product.
