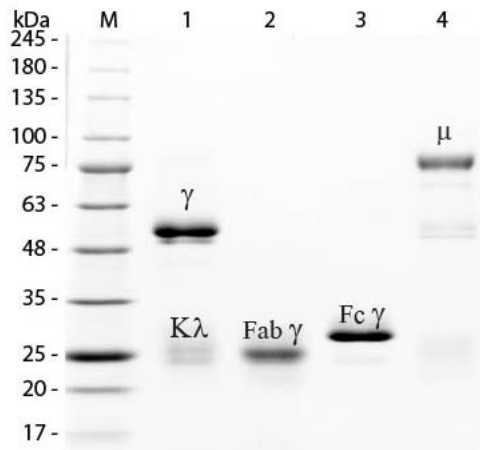

Storage Condition	Store vial at 4° C prior to restoration. For extended storage aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

Application Note	Rabbit IgG F(ab') ₂ fragment Texas Red™ is designed for immunofluorescence microscopy, fluorescence based plate assays (FLISA) and fluorescent western blotting. This product is also suitable for multiplex analysis, including multicolor imaging, utilizing various commercial platforms.
Background	Secreted as part of the adaptive immune response by plasma B cells, immunoglobulin G constitutes 75% of serum immunoglobulins. Immunoglobulin G binds to viruses, bacteria, as well as fungi and facilitates their destruction or neutralization via agglutination (and thereby immobilizing them), activation of the complement cascade, and opsonization for phagocytosis. This product possesses the F(ab') ₂ fragment, recognized by the two F(ab) fragments yielded from the digestion of the antibody below the disulfide bond hinge region.
Purity And Specificity	This product was prepared from normal serum by delipidation, salt fractionation, ion exchange chromatography followed by pepsin digestion and extensive dialysis against the buffer stated above. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Rabbit IgG, anti-Rabbit IgG F(ab') ₂ and anti-Rabbit Serum. No reaction was observed against anti-Rabbit IgG F(c) or anti-Pepsin.
Expiration	Expiration date is one (1) year from date of opening.
