This product is also suitable for multiplex **Application Note** analysis, including multicolor imaging, utilizing various commercial platforms. Background Secreted as part of the adaptive immune response by plasma B cells, immunoglobulin G constitutes 75% of serum immunoglobulins. Immunoglobulin G binds to viruses, bacteria, as well as fungi and facilitates their destruction or neutralization via agglutination (and thereby immobilizing them), activation of the compliment cascade, and opsinization for phagocytosis. This product possesses the F(c) region, recognized by high-affinity Fc receptor proteins. This product was prepared from normal serum by delipidation, salt fractionation, ion exchange chromatography followed by papain digestion and extensive dialysis against the buffer stated above. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Rat IgG, anti-Rat IgG F(c) and anti-Rat **Purity And Specificity** Serum. No reaction was observed against anti-Rat IgG F(ab')2 or anti-Papain. 
