Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

<b>Application Note</b>	This product has been assayed against 1.0 µg of Alkaline Phosphatase [Human Intestine] in a standard ELISA using Peroxidase conjugated Affinity Purified anti-Rabbit IgG [H&L] (Goat) code #611-1302 and (ABTS (2,2'-azino-bis-[3-ethylbenthiazoline-6-sulfonic acid]) code # ABTS-100 as a substrate for 30 minutes at room temperature. A working dilution of 1:5,000 to 1:20,000 of the reconstitution concentration is suggested for this product.
<b>Background</b>	In most mammals there are four different isozymes: placental, placental-like, intestinal and tissue non-specific (liver/bone/kidney). Alkaline Phosphatase catalytic activity is phosphate monoester + H <sub>2</sub> O = an alcohol + phosphate.
<b>Purity And Specificity</b>	This product was prepared from monospecific antiserum by a delipidation and defibrination. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-rabbit serum, purified and partially purified Alkaline Phosphatase [Human Intestine]. Cross reactivity against Alkaline Phosphatase from other tissues and species may occur but have not been specifically determined.



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Both the antiserum and IgG fractions of anti-Alkaline Phosphatase (Human Intestine) are shown to detect under reducing conditions of SDS-PAGE the 60,000 dalton enzyme in cellular extracts. Approximately 10 ug of total protein is loaded per lane. A 1:5,000 dilution of the primary antibody is used followed by detection using HRP Goat-a-Rabbit IgG [H&L] (611-1302) diluted 1:4,000 and color development using 4-CN substrate until sufficient color develops. Other detection systems will yield similar results.
