PRODUCTION PROCEDURES Antiserum was solid phase adsorbed to ensure class specificity. The antibody was isolated by affinity chromatography using antigen coupled to agarose beads.

Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.

By immunoelectrophoresis and ELISA this antibody reacts specifically with bovine IgM. This antibody may cross react with IgM from other species.

APPLICATIONS Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.

Immunocytochemistry 1:200 – 1:2,000

ELISA 1:1,000 – 1:30,000; for coating plates 1:100 – 1:500
