PRODUCTION PROCEDURES Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to Aprataxin immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A300-148A maps to a region between residues 100 and 150 of human Aprataxin using the numbering given in SwissProt Entry Q7Z2E3 (GeneID 54840).

Immunoglobulin concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.

APPLICATIONS Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.

Immunoprecipitation 5 - 10 µg/mg lysate

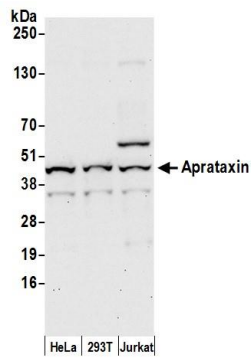
Western blot of lysates performed using standard western blot reagents and 4-20% SDS-PAGE.

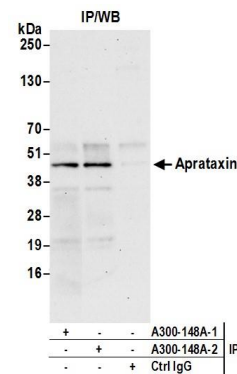

Detection of human Aprataxin by western blot. *Samples:* Whole cell lysate (50 µg) from HeLa, HEK293T, and Jurkat cells prepared using NETN lysis buffer. *Antibody:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-Aprataxin antibody A300-148A (lot A300-148A-2) used for WB at 0.1 µg/ml. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 30 seconds.



Detection of human Aprataxin by western blot of immunoprecipitates. *Samples:* Whole cell lysate (1.0 mg per IP reaction; 20% of IP loaded) from Jurkat cells prepared using NETN lysis buffer. *Antibodies:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-Aprataxin antibody A300-148A (lot A300-148A-2) used for IP at 6 µg/mg lysate. Aprataxin was also immunoprecipitated by a previous lot of this antibody (lot A300-148A-1). For blotting immunoprecipitated Aprataxin, A300-148A was used at 1 µg/ml. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 30 seconds.
