PRODUCTION PROCEDURES

Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to PAK1 immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A301-259A maps to a region between residue 1 and 50 of human p21/Cdc42/Rac1-activated kinase 1 using the numbering given in entry NP_002567.3 (GeneID

5058).

Immunoglobulin concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm

of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.

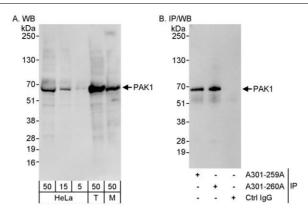

Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti-PAK1 antibody A301-259A used for WB at 0.04 μ g/ml (A) and 0.1 μ g/ml (B) and used for IP at 3 μ g/mg lysate. PAK1 was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-PAK1 antibody A301-260A, which recognizes a downstream epitope. Detection: Chemiluminescence with exposure times of 10 seconds (A and B).
