PRODUCTION PROCEDURES	Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to DOCK10 immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A301-305A maps to a region between residue 2136 and 2186 of human dedicator of cytokinesis 10 using the numbering given in entry NP_055504.2 (GeneID 55619).

Immunoglobulin concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.

APPLICATIONS Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.
