of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.



HCF1 Antibody A301-399A



Detection of human HCF1 by western blot and immunoprecipitation. *Samples:* Whole cell lysate (5, 15 and 50 μg for WB; 1 mg for IP, 20% of IP loaded) from HeLa cells. *Antibodies:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-HCF1 antibody A301–399A used for WB at 0.04 μg/ml (A) and 1 μg/ml (B) and used for IP at 3 μg/mg lysate. HCF1 was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-HCF1 antibody A301–400A, which recognizes a downstream epitope. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with exposure times of 30 seconds (A) and 10 seconds (B).
