PRODUCTION PROCEDURES

Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to Anillin immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A301-405A maps to a region between residue 1 and 50 of human actin binding protein Anillin using the numbering given in entry NP_061155.2 (GenelD 54443).

Immunoglobulin concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm

of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.



Detection of human Anillin by western blot and immunoprecipitation. Samples: Whole cell lysate from HeLa (5, 15 and 50 μ g for WB; 1 mg for IP, 20% of IP loaded) and HEK293T (T; 50 μ g) cells. Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti–Anillin antibody A301–405A used for WB at 0.04 μ g/ml (A) and 1 μ g/ml (B) and used for IP at 3 μ g/mg lysate. Anillin was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti–Anillin antibody A301–406A, which recognizes a downstream epitope. Detection: Chemiluminescence with exposure times of 30 seconds (A) and 3 seconds (B).
