NP_060404.3 (GeneID 55023).

Immunoglobulin concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm

of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.



PHIP Antibody A302-055A



Detection of human PHIP by western blot and immunoprecipitation. Samples: Whole cell lysate (5, 15 and 50 μ g for WB; 1 mg for IP, 20% of IP loaded) from HeLa cells. Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti-PHIP antibody A302-055A used for WB at 0.04 μ g/ml (A) and 1 μ g/ml (B) and used for IP at 3 μ g/mg lysate. PHIP was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-PHIP antibody A302-054A, which recognizes an upstream epitope. Detection: Chemiluminescence with exposure times of 3 minutes seconds (A and B).
