Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to CEP192 immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A302-324A maps to a region between residue 1800 and 1850 of human centrosomal protein 192kDa using the numbering given in entry NP\_115518.2 (GeneID

55125).

Immunoglobulin concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm

of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.



Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti–CEP192 antibody A302–324A used for WB at 0.4  $\mu$ g/ml (A) and 1  $\mu$ g/ml (B) and used for IP at 10  $\mu$ g/mg lysate. CEP192 was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti–CEP192 antibody BL6868, which recognizes an upstream epitope. Detection: Chemiluminescence with exposure times of 3 minutes (A) and 30 seconds (B).
