PRODUCTION PROCEDURES

Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to DUSP10 immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A302-428A maps to a region between residue 432 and 482 of human dual specificity phosphatase 10 using the numbering given in entry NP\_009138.1 (GeneID

11221).

Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4

equals 1.0 mg of IgG.



Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti-DUSP10 antibody A302-428A used for WB at 0.4  $\mu$ g/ml (A) and 1  $\mu$ g/ml (B) and used for IP at 10  $\mu$ g/mg lysate. DUSP10 was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-DUSP10 antibody BL5323, which recognizes an upstream epitope. Detection: Chemiluminescence with exposure times of 3 minutes (A) and 30 seconds (B).
