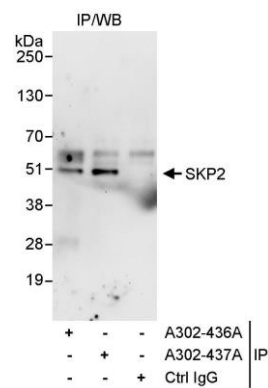

PRODUCTION PROCEDURES	Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to SKP2 immobilized on solid support. The epitope recognized by A302-437A maps to a region between residue 50 and 100 of human S-phase kinase-associated protein 2 using the numbering given in entry NP_005974.2 (GeneID 6502). Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.
APPLICATIONS	Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use. Western Blot Not recommended. Use rabbit anti-SKP2 antibody A302-436A. Immunoprecipitation 10 – 15 µg/mg lysate

Detection of human SKP2 by western blot of immunoprecipitates. *Samples:* Whole cell lysate (1 mg for IP, 20% of IP loaded) from HeLa cells. *Antibodies:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-SKP2 antibody A302-437A used for IP at 10 µg/mg lysate. SKP2 was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-SKP2 antibody A302-436A, which recognizes an upstream epitope. For blotting immunoprecipitated SKP2, A302-436A was used at 1 µg/ml. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 1 minute.
