PRODUCTION PROCEDURES

Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to Cingulin immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A303-327A maps to a region between residue 200 and 250 of human

Cingulin using the numbering given in entry NP\_065821.1 (GeneID 57530).

Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4

equals 1.0 mg of IgG.

**APPLICATIONS** Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined

experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.

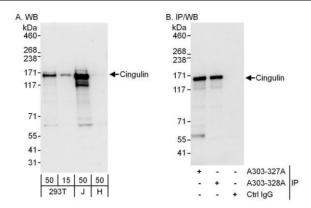

Samples: Whole cell lysate from HEK293T (15 and 50 μg for WB; 1 mg for IP, 20% of IP loaded), Jurkat (J; 50 μg) and HeLa (H; 50 μg) cells. Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti-Cingulin antibody A303-327A used for WB at 0.1 μg/ml (A) and 1 μg/ml (B) and used for IP at 6 μg/mg lysate. Cingulin was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-Cingulin antibody A303-328A, which recognizes a downstream epitope. Detection: Chemiluminescence with exposure times of 10 seconds (A) and 3 seconds (B).
