PRODUCTION PROCEDURES

Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to SAMHD1 immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A303-690A maps to a region between residue 450 and 500 of human SAM Domain and HD Domain 1 using the numbering given in entry NP\_056289.2 (GenelD 25939).

Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4

equals 1.0 mg of IgG.

APPLICATIONS Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined

experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.

Western Blot 1:2,000 - 1:10,000 Immunoprecipitation 2 - 10 µg/mg lysate

Immunohistochemistry 1:500 - 1:5,000. Epitope retrieval with citrate buffer pH 6.0 is

recommended for FFPE tissue sections.




