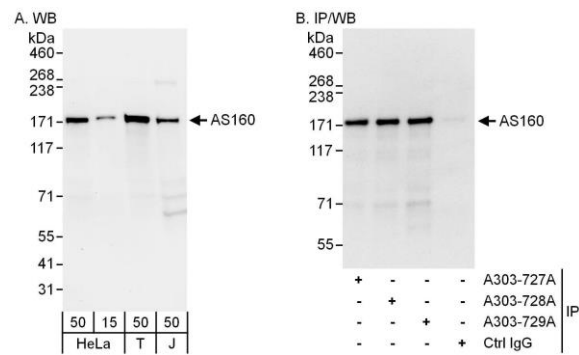

**Detection of human AS160 by western blot and immunoprecipitation.** *Samples:* Whole cell lysate from HeLa (15 and 50 µg for WB; 1 mg for IP, 20% of IP loaded), HEK293T (T; 50 µg) and Jurkat (J; 50 µg) cells. *Antibodies:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-AS160 antibody A303-729A used for WB at 0.1 µg/ml (A) and 1 µg/ml (B) and used for IP at 6 µg/mg lysate. AS160 was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-AS160 antibodies A303-727A and A303-728A, which recognize upstream epitopes. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with exposure times of 10 seconds (A) and 3 sec (B).
