PRODUCTION PROCEDURES

Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to ZPR9 immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A304-075A maps to a region between residue 25 to 75 of human Zinc Finger Protein 622 using the numbering given in entry NP_219482.1 (GeneID 90441).

Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4

equals 1.0 mg of IgG.





Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti-ZPR9 antibody A304-075A (lot A304-075A-1) used for WB at 0.4 μg/ml. Detection: Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 10 seconds.

Detection of human ZPR9 by western blot of immunoprecipitates. Samples: Whole cell lysate (1 mg for IP; 20% of IP loaded) from HeLa cells. Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti–ZPR9 antibody A304–075A (lot A304–075A–1) used for IP at 6 μ g/mg lysate. ZPR9 was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti–ZPR9 antibodies A304–076A and A304–077A. For blotting immunoprecipitated ZPR9, A304–075A was used at 0.4 μ g/ml. Detection: Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 10 seconds.
