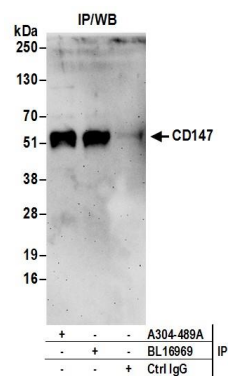

PRODUCTION PROCEDURES	<p>Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to CD147 immobilized on solid support.</p> <p>The epitope recognized by A304-489A maps to a region between residue 325 to 375 of human CD147 Antigen using the numbering given in entry NP_001719.2 (GeneID 682).</p> <p>Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.</p>
APPLICATIONS	<p>Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.</p> <p>Western Blot Not recommended. Use rabbit anti-CD147 antibody A304-488A.</p> <p>Immunoprecipitation 2 – 10 µg/mg lysate</p>

Detection of human CD147 by western blot of immunoprecipitates. *Samples:* Whole cell lysate (0.5 or 1.0 mg per IP reaction; 20% of IP loaded) from HeLa cells prepared using NETN lysis buffer. *Antibodies:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-CD147 antibody A304-489A (lot A304-489A-1) used for IP at 6 µg per reaction. CD147 was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-CD147 antibody BL16969. For blotting immunoprecipitated CD147, A304-489A was used at 1 µg/ml. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 3 minutes.
