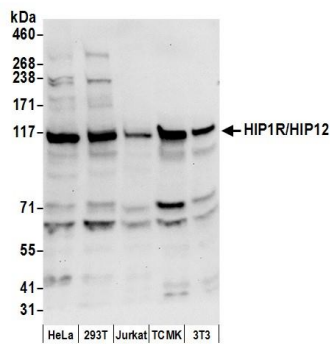

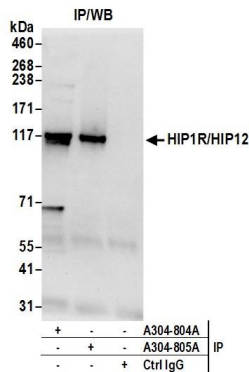

PRODUCTION PROCEDURES	Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to HIP1R/HIP12 immobilized on solid support. The epitope recognized by A304-804A maps to a region between residue 1 to 50 of human Huntingtin-Interacting Protein 1-Related Protein using the numbering given in entry O75146.2 (GeneID 9026). Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.
APPLICATIONS	Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use. Western Blot 1:2,000 – 1:10,000 Immunoprecipitation 2 – 10 µg/mg lysate
APPLICATION NOTES	Western blot of immunoprecipitates performed using Normal Pig Serum (Cat. No. S100-020), Goat anti-Rabbit Light Chain HRP Conjugate (Cat. No. A120-113P) and 4-8% SDS-PAGE (link to IP-western blot protocol in Additional Info section below). Western blot of lysates performed using standard western blot reagents and 4-8% SDS-PAGE.

Detection of human and mouse HIP1R/HIP12 by western blot. *Samples:* Whole cell lysate (50 µg) from HeLa, HEK293T, Jurkat, mouse TCMK-1, and mouse NIH 3T3 cells prepared using NETN lysis buffer. *Antibody:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-HIP1R/HIP12 antibody A304-804A (lot A304-804A-1) used for WB at 0.1 µg/ml. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 10 seconds.



Detection of human HIP1R/HIP12 by western blot of immunoprecipitates. *Samples:* Whole cell lysate (0.5 or 1.0 mg per IP reaction; 20% of IP loaded) from 293T cells prepared using NETN lysis buffer. *Antibodies:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-HIP1R/HIP12 antibody A304-804A (lot A304-804A-1) used for IP at 6 µg per reaction. HIP1R/HIP12 was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-HIP1R/HIP12 antibody A304-805A. For blotting immunoprecipitated HIP1R/HIP12, A304-804A was used at 0.4 µg/ml. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 10 seconds.
