PRODUCTION PROCEDURES Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to STAM2 immobilized on solid support. The epitope recognized by A304-818A maps to a region between residue 175 to 225 of human Signal transducing adapter molecule 2 using the numbering given in entry O75886.1 (GeneID 10254).

Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.

APPLICATIONS Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.

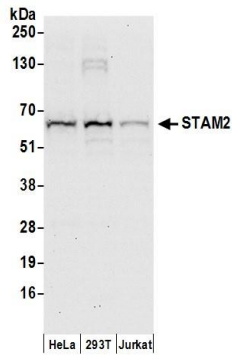

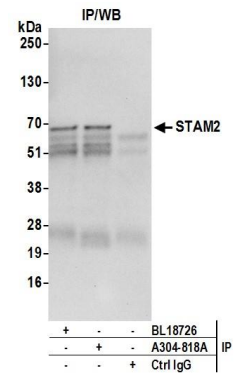
Western blot of lysates performed using standard western blot reagents and 4-20% SDS-PAGE.

Detection of human STAM2 by western blot. *Samples:* Whole cell lysate (50 µg) from HeLa, HEK293T, and Jurkat cells prepared using NETN lysis buffer. *Antibody:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-STAM2 antibody A304-818A (lot A304-818A-1) used for WB at 0.1 µg/ml. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 30 seconds.



Detection of human STAM2 by western blot of immunoprecipitates. *Samples:* Whole cell lysate (0.5 or 1.0 mg per IP reaction; 20% of IP loaded) from Jurkat cells prepared using NETN lysis buffer. *Antibody:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-STAM2 antibody A304-818A (lot A304-818A-1) used for IP at 6 µg per reaction. STAM2 was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-STAM2 antibody BL18726. For blotting immunoprecipitated STAM2, A304-818A was used at 0.4 µg/ml. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 10 seconds.
