PRODUCTION PROCEDURES	Recombinant antibody was purified from cell culture supernatant. Immunogen was a peptide representing a region between residue 1 and 50 of human transcription factor PU.1 using the numbering given in entry NP_003111.2 (Gene ID 6688).
APPLICATIONS	Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use. A700-178CF is the carrier-free version of A700-178, which is qualified for use in Western Blot, Immunoprecipitation, Immunohistochemistry, and/or Immunocytochemistry. The format of A700-178CF is designed for compatibility with the labeling of the antibody such as with fluorochromes, metal isotopes, oligonucleotides, and enzymes. Upon completion of labeling, the user must empirically define the assay dependent concentration for use.
