PRODUCTION PROCEDURES	Goats were immunized with purified human albumin of serum or plasma origin. The antiserum was fractionated and passed over DEAE to yield an IgG fraction.

By immunoelectrophoresis, the antiserum reacts specifically with human albumin. No antibody was detected against other serum proteins.

APPLICATIONS Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.
