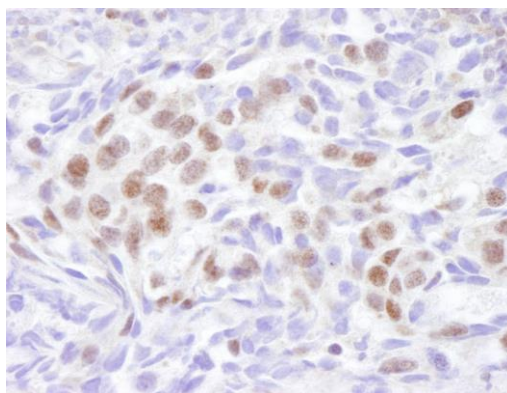

PRODUCTION PROCEDURES	Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to EDD1 immobilized on solid support. The epitope recognized by IHC-00025 maps to a region between residue 600 and 650 of human E3 Ubiquitin Protein Ligase, HECT domain containing 1 using the numbering given in entry NP_056986.2 (GeneID 51366).
APPLICATIONS	Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use. Immunohistochemistry 1:100 – 1:500
APPLICATION NOTES	Epitope exposure is recommended. Epitope exposure with citrate buffer will enhance staining. Likely to work with frozen sections.
IHC HUMAN CONTROLS	In some cases, the antibody may be diluted further than indicated. Breast Carcinoma, Prostate Carcinoma, Stomach Adenocarcinoma, Testicular Seminoma
