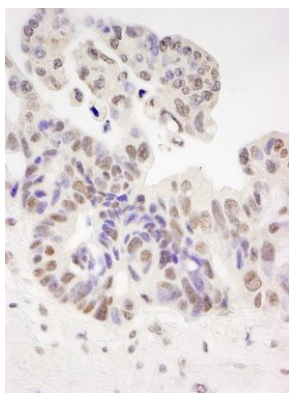

PRESUMED REACTIVITY	Based on 100% sequence identity, this antibody is predicted to react with Orangutan, Monkey, Gorilla, Chimpanzee, Northern white-cheeked gibbon, Crab-eating macaque and White-tufted-ear marmoset

PRODUCTION PROCEDURES	Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to Tat-SF1 immobilized on solid support. The epitope recognized by IHC-00424 maps to a region between residue 375 and 425 of human HIV-1 Tat specific factor 1 using the numbering given in entry NP_055315.2 (GeneID 27336). Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.
APPLICATIONS	Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use. Immunohistochemistry 1:100 – 1:500
APPLICATION NOTES	Epitope exposure is recommended. Epitope exposure with tris-EDTA pH9.0 buffer will enhance staining. Likely to work with frozen sections.
IHC HUMAN CONTROLS	In some cases, the antibody may be diluted further than indicated. Anaplastic Thyroid Carcinoma, Breast Carcinoma, Colon Carcinoma, Ovarian Carcinoma, Pancreatic Islet Cell Tumor, Prostate Carcinoma
