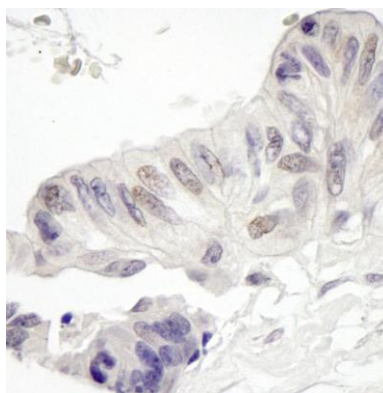

PRODUCTION PROCEDURES	<p>Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to MAML1 immobilized on solid support.</p> <p>The epitope recognized by IHC-00445 maps to a region between residue 75 and 125 of human Mastermind-like 1 using the numbering given in entry NP_055572.1 (GeneID 9794).</p> <p>Immunoglobulin concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.</p>
APPLICATIONS	<p>Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.</p> <p>Immunohistochemistry 1:100 – 1:500</p>
APPLICATION NOTES	<p>Epitope exposure is recommended.</p> <p>Epitope exposure with tris-EDTA pH9.0 buffer will enhance staining.</p> <p>Likely to work with frozen sections.</p> <p>In some cases, the antibody may be diluted further than indicated.</p>
