Description: anti-GRB7 Mouse Monoclonal Antibody

Background: Grb7 is an adaptor protein that interacts with epidermal growth factor receptor (EGFR) and ephrin receptors. It plays a role in the integrin signaling pathway and cell migration by binding with focal adhesion kinase (FAK). Grb7 gene is commonly co-amplified (present in excess copies) in breast cancers. Grb7 is over-expressed in testicular germ cell tumors, esophageal cancers, and gastric cancers. There are clues that it involved in cell migration and metastatic progression of human esophageal carcinomas.

Immunogen: Purified GRB7 protein, human origin.

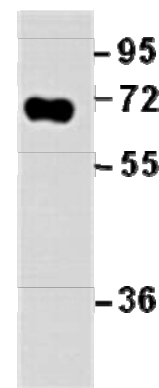
Constituents: PBS (without Mg²⁺ and Ca²⁺), pH 7.4, 150 mM NaCl, 50% glycerol

Species Reactivity: Recognizes GRB7 of vertebrates.

Storage Conditions: Store at -20°C. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles

GRB7 protein



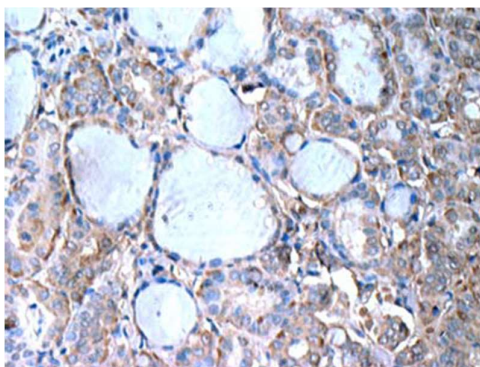
WB: Anti-GRB7 mAb

Western blot analysis of recombinant GRB7 protein.

Purified His-tagged GRB7 protein was blotted with anti-GRB7 mouse monoclonal antibody (Cat. # 26133).

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Immunohistochemistry:



Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded human breast cancer tissue with anti-GRB7 monoclonal antibody (Cat. #26133). Tissue samples were fixed with formaldehyde and blocked with 1% serum for 15min at 37 °C. Antigen retrieval was by heat mediation in citrate buffer (pH6). Samples were then incubated with primary antibody (1:50 dilution) overnight at 4°C. A HRP-conjugated Goat anti-mouse IgG (1:50 dilution) was used as secondary antibody.

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
