Background: The protein FGFR1 is highly conserved between members and throughout evolution. This particular family member of FGFR1 binds both acidic and basic fibroblast growth factors and is involved in limb induction. Mutations of FGFR1 protein have been associated with Pfeiffer syndrome, Jackson-Weiss syndrome, Antley-Bixler syndrome, osteoglophonic dysplasia, squamouscell lung cancer and autosomal dominant Kallmann

syndrome.

Immunogen: A synthetic peptide from the internal region of FGFR1, which includes the

mutation of P252T, human origin.


Species Reactivity: Recognizes P252T mutant, but

Western blot analysis of recombinant FGFR1(P252T) and wild type proteins.

Purified His-tagged FGFR1(P252T) protein (22-376 aa,45KD, lane 2) and corresponding wild type protein (lane 1) were blotted with anti-FGFR1(P252T) monoclonal antibody (Cat. # 26253).


