Background: GNAQ is a protein that in humans encoded by the GNAQ gene. The GNAQ protein, an alpha subunit in the Gq class, couples a seventransmembrane domain receptor to activation of phospholipase C-beta. Mutations at this locus have been associated with problems in platelet activation and aggregation.



Western blot analysis of recombinant GNAQ protein.


Purified His-tagged GNAQ protein was blotted with anti-GNAQ monoclonal antibody (Cat. # 26356).
